# 3. <u>APPLICATION FOR PSV (TAXI) LICENCES</u>

## **Established Policy for Public Service (Taxi) Licence**

Note: Any applicant of a Public Service (Taxi) Licence, new or on transfer, shall:

- (a) not be holder of any Road Service Licence in his personal name; or
- (b) not be a director or a shareholder of any company holding a Road Service Licence.

# Transfer of licence

Upon enquiry – Refer to Licensing Board.

General Transfers according to Section 93 of RTA.

- Transfer, on a case to case basis, to Full Time 5 years' continuous employment in the same taxi as Full Time Driver. Contribution to CSG (Receipt of payment).
- 2. Transfer to Part Time Not applicable.
- 3. Transfer to next kin.

#### **Death of Licensee:**

In case of death, death certificate and an affidavit from all heirs to be submitted.

Successor to submit a clean certificate of character.

### **Incapacity:**

A Government Medical Certificate and a certificate from the Ministry of Social Security to be submitted (incapacity). Representative of licensee to submit a clean certificate of character.

## **Bankruptcy:**

In case of bankruptcy, a letter from CBRD to be submitted.

Section 93 of RTA refers: In the event of death of licensee, incapacity, bankruptcy of liquidation of the business.

If any one of either holder of licence or FT driver has not a clean Certificate of Character, clean criminal record, application not to be considered.

Sworn Affidavit to be produced.

Mutual Transfer / Change of BOP  Upon enquiry — Refer to Licensing Board.  1. Mutual transfers on a case to case basis.  2. Holder of licence must have operated at initial base of operation for at least 3 years to be eligible to apply for mutual transfer or temporary relocation under Section 80 (5) of RTA.	Clean Certificate of Character. Clean Criminal Record. Valid Driving Licence.  No objection letter from 2/3 of holder of taxi Licences located at proposed BOP.
